


Santa Rosa Quilt Guild

Corner

Due Thursday, August 4, 2016



Modern fabrics are bold in color and print with high contrast. Modern blocks are updated classic quilt patterns. The designs are minimalist with large areas of negative space.


Supplies: Choose three fabrics. Yellow for Color 1 (the center); pink for Color 2; and gray for Color 3. Use anything that looks modern to you. It doesn't have to be a solid. Have fun with it!

Cutting: From Color 1 (yellow center) cut one $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square
From Color 2 (pink) cut one $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square and one $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 6" strip
From Color 3 (gray) cut two 2" x 6" strips and two 2" x 9" strips


Assemble: Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout.




Sew the Color 1 (yellow center) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square to the Color 2 (pink) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square



Sew the Color 2 (pink) $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x6" to the unit. Center should be in the lower left of the completed unit.



Sew a Color 3 (gray) 2"x6" strip to both sides of the unit.



Sew of Color 3 (gray) 2"x9" strip to the top and bottom of the unit

Write your name on the seam allowance or pin your name to your block. Block is complete and will measure 9" x 9" unfinished and $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " finished.

All blocks for the 2016 BOM modern sampler will measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make one for Block of the Month and one for yourself if you would like to have a modern sampler at the end of the year.
