

Amazon Smile Tutorial


With the current pandemic, we are all shopping from home now more than ever. It's easy, convenient and our items get delivered right to the door. Earlier in the year we did a tutorial on "AmazonSmile". If you haven't already signed up I want to go over with you how it works.

Every time you use AmazonSmile to order something online, a small percentage of your purchase goes to your favorite charitable organization, i.e. Santa Rosa Quilt Guild.

It's very easy to get started and it costs you nothing. All you need is an Amazon account, which most of us already have. If you don't have an account you can sign up for one by visiting amazon.com.

You want to start by going to smile.amazon.com. You will be prompted to enter your login information.

Once logged in you will be guided to a page that says "Get Started". Click on that button.

Shop at smile.amazon.com and we'll donate 0.5% of eligible purchases to your favorite charitable organization—no fees, no extra cost.


Donate products to charity

The next screen will pop up and have the name of the Santa Rosa Quilt Guild with a button that says “select” to the right of it. Click on that button.


