Block of the Month

Due March 1, 2018

"F" is for Flying Geese



Celebrate the Color of the Year 2018, Ultra Violet! Include 3 contrasting colors, using at least one value in the ultra violet hue. Block is 9 1/2" unfinished.

Cut the following:

- Background to Flying Geese: Cut 8 – 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
- Flying Geese: Cut 4 – 2 3/4" x 5"
- Side Panels: Cut 2 – 2 3/4" x 9 1/2"

Sewing:

Sew scant 1/4" seams.



Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all 8 squares. Lay one square on one side of the rectangle, RST (right sides together). Stitch on the marked line.

Tip: Draw the line first to avoid any "wonkyness" in your seam.



Trim off excess, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
Press seam to outside.

Lay 2nd square on the opposite side of the rectangle, RST. Stitch on the marked line.

Trim off excess, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Press seam to outside.

Congratulations! You have just sewn one flying geese unit!

Repeat these steps to make 3 more flying geese units, for a total of 4 units.

Sew all 4 units together, pressing each seam toward the point of the flying geese.

Sew side panels to either side of flying geese unit.
Press seams to outside.

You are done! Awesome job!
