

Christmas Sweater

Background fabric:

- 6 - 3 1/2". Squares (for the sleeves)
- 2 - 5" by 2 1/2" side panels for the collar
- 1 - 2" by 3 1/2" (top of the collar)
- 1 - 2" by 12 1/2" bottom of the block



1. Make a Strata of Christmas Fabric no more than 2" wide strips. Make the Strata 9" long by 6 1/2" wide for the body of the sweater.
2. Make another Strata for the sleeves. Make it big enough to cut 2 sleeves 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"
3. One 1" by 3 1/2" strip (collar)



THE SLEEVES

Sew all of your 6" Christmas fabric strips together and cut 2 blocks from the strip sets into 3.5 " blocks. Sew , cut and flip the right and left sleeve as shown below. Then add the 3.5" square to the bottom of each sleeve



THE BODY OF THE SWEATER

Sew all the 6.5" strips together to make a 9" block. Then sew the sleeves on each side of the body.



THE COLLAR

Sew the 1" strip of Christmas fabric to the 1.5" strip of background fabric. Then add the 5" strips to both sides of the collar . Attach that entire unit to the sweater unit and finally add your 12.5" by 2" strip of background fabric to the bottom and holy moly Santa Clausy you have the ugly Christmas sweater!!!
