Block-of-the-Month

"WINTER SCARF"

Oh the weather outside is frightful ... well maybe not here in Sonoma County, but you can always use another scarf. This quick block is a lot of fun to make. Be creative with the fringe, if you like. You can use a piece of striped fabric, or make a fringe out of yarn like the block on the right. Have fun with it!



Cutting Instructions: (see photo 1)

Background (white or light):

A - 2 ea. 2-1/2" square

B - 1 ea. 4-1/2" x 8-1/2"

C - 1 ea. 2-1/2" x 8-1/2"

D - 2 ea. 2-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Side Pieces:

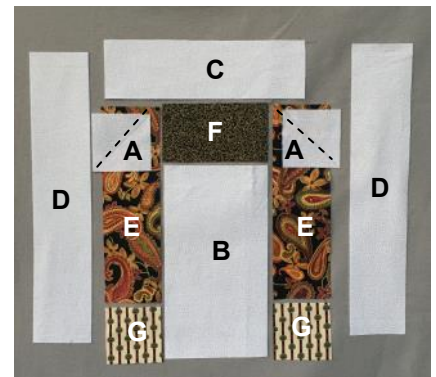
E - 2 ea. 2-1/2" x 8-1/2"

Back (darker than sides):

F - 1 ea. 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Fringe:

G - 2 ea 2-1/2" square



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Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal on 2 A pieces. Sew on diagonal to each E piece as shown. Cut 1/4" from diagonal, remove excess fabric. Press open.
2. Sew G to the other end of both E pieces. Sew F to B. (photo 2)
3. Sew C to the top of step 2. (photo 3)
4. Sew D to each side. (photo 3)

Unfinished block is 12-1/2" square.

Be sure to sign your block.
