

Santa Rosa Quilt Guild Block-of-the-Month May 2023 "Wooden Spools"

Fabric:

White / off white fabric:

8 ea. 2-1/2" X 7-1/4" rectangles

Brown fabric (may use 4 different shades/designs)

8 ea. 2-1/2" X 7-1/4" rectangles

Colored fabrics: 4 different colors

ea. 2-1/2" squares

Cutting and Marking Instructions:

- 1. Cut all of the 2-1/2" x 7-1/4" rectangles at 45 degrees on both ends to form trapezoids. Mark the center of the top of each trapezoid
- 2. Mark the centers of each side of the squares as well as the seam ending point

1/4"at each corner.

It is helpful to lay out all of the block pieces into the design before beginning to sew.

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Join a white trapezoid to a center square aligning the center marks. It is important to end the seam at exactly 1/4" from the edge. Join a second white trapezoid on the opposite side
- 2. Join two brown trapezoids to the center square (also on opposite sides). Be careful not to cross into the seam of the first trapezoids at the corner of the square.
- Align the tips of an adjacent trapezoid side and sew from the tip to the corner of the square. It is helpful
 to fold the center square outward and make the pieces as flat as possible to sew. Again, be careful not
 to stitch into the square. You may also want to backstitch at the end. Repeat for all of the trapezoid side
 seams.
- 4. Press trapezoid seams to the dark fabric. Admire your completed block!!!
