## Santa Rosa Quilt Guild

## Block-of-the-Month

## October 2023

## "Auturnn Leaf"

## Fabric

Off white background
1 ea. 4-1/2" square (A)
3 ea. 5 " squares ( $B$ )

Color Fabric (Red, Yellow, Orange or Green)
3 ea. 4-1/2" squares (C)
2 ea. 5 " squares ( $D$ )
1 ea. 1 " x 6-1/2" strip (E)

## Sewing Instructions:

1. Lay out fabric pieces as shown in Figure 1 before sewing the block.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of two $5^{\prime \prime}$ background squares (B).
3. Place right sides of 5 " background squares $(\mathrm{B})$ to right sides of color 5 " squares (D).
4. Sew on either side of the lines, press to dark side, and square up to four 41/2" blocks. (Figure 2)
5. Sew (C) squares to (B/D) squares to form the leaf.
6. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of the third 5 " background square (B) and cut on the line.
7. Sew the 1 " $\times 6$ " color strip ( $E$ ) to one side of the cut 5 " background $(B)$, right side to right side.
8. Repeat step 7 for the other side of the stem (Figure 3.)
9. Press to the dark sides and square up to $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
10. Assemble the nine blocks, as shown in Figure 1.

11. Press and square up to a 12-1/2" block.

It's important to sew this block with a consistent $1 / 4$ " seam. We built this block using fabric from our stashes. Our Autumn Leaf is a quick and easy block to sew, so we hope you'll submit several to us. Please write your name on a back side seam of each block you submit, so you'll be eligible to win more blocks. The drawing(s) will be held at our guild meeting on December 7 .
