

Santa Rosa Quilt Guild Block-of-the-Month July 2025 **"Keepsake Star"** 

## Fabric:

White Solid or Tone-on-Tone	Blue Print or Solid	Red Print or Solid
2 ea. 5" Squares (A)	8 ea. 2-1/2" squares (C)	2 ea. 5" squares (B)
4 ea. 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (D)	1 ea. 4-1/2" square (F)	4 ea. 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (E)

## **Sewing Directions:**

- Corner units: On the wrong side of each white 5" (A) square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner. Place a white 5" (A) square and red 5" (B) square together. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the squares apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles (B). Repeat to make 4 A/B HSTs. Trim to 4-1/2".
- Flying geese units: On the wrong side of each blue 2-1/2" (C) square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner. Using the white 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (D) rectangles make four flying geese units. Unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".

3. Lay out one C/D flying geese and one red 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (E) rectangle as shown. Sew together to make a flying geese unit. Press seam towards the E rectangle. Repeat to make four flying geese units measuring 4-1/2" square.

4. Assembly: Lay out the corner units, flying geese units, and blue 4-1/2" square (F) as shown in photo at top. Join the units into rows, then sew the rows together to make the full block.

Block should measure 12-1/2" square.
