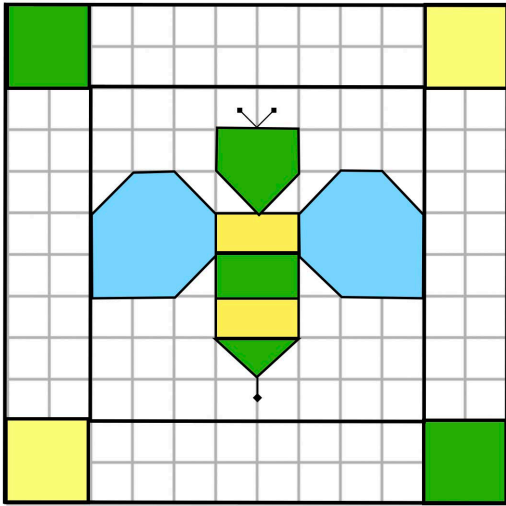

“Bee”

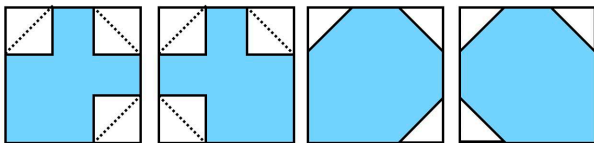


Fabric: colors of your choosing

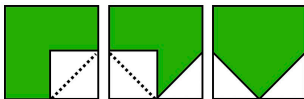
Background(BG)	Wings	Head, Body stripes, Corners.(Dark)
2- 3½" x 2½"	2- 3½" x 3½"	2- 2½" x 1½"
2- 3½" x 3½"		3- 2½" x 2½"(CS)
10- 1½" x 1½"		
2- 2½" x 1½"	Body stripes, Corners (Light)	
4- 8½" x 2½"	2-2½" x 1½"	
	2-2½" x 2½"(CS)	

Sewing Directions:

1. Wings. Sew (BG) 1½"sq. to:
Left wing, top right, top left and bottom left of wing.
Right wing, top right, top left and bottom right of wing,



2. Sew (BG) 2½ x 3½ rectangles to top of wing units.
3. Sew (BG) 3½ x 3½ squares to bottom of wing units.
4. Head. Sew (BG) 2½ x 1½ to top of dark 2½ sq.
Sew (BG) 1½ squares to right and left bottom corners of head.



5. Body. Below head sew alternating 2½ x 1½ dark and light stripes.
Light, dark, light, dark.
Sew (BG) 1½" squares to bottom to the bottom left and right corners of the last dark stripe.
6. Sew body to wings units. Trim to 8½" square.
7. Make Sashings. Sew (BG) 8½ x 2½ to sides of Bee.
Add (CS) 2½ squares to either side of 2 of the (BG) 8½ x 2½. Sew onto the Bee. Trim to 12½ sq.
8. Optional: Embroider antenna and stinger
9. Write your name on back
10. Drawing will be in September
