

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background:
2 ea. 8-3/4" squares

Santa Rosa Quilt Guild
Block-of-the-Month
May 2022
"Whirligig"

Color fabrics: Two different colors
1 ea. $8-3 / 4$ " square of each color

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. On the wrong side of the background square, draw two diagonal lines $(X)$.
2. Align one background square with one color square, right sides together.
3. Sew $1 / 4$ " on both sides of both lines $(X)$. (Picture 2)
4. Cut in half top to bottom and left to right (+).
5. Cut on diagonal lines $(X)$ to make eight half-square triangles. (Picture 3)
6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 with the second background and second color square to make another eight half-square triangles.
7. Press the half-square triangles to the color side, and square up each one to 3-1/2", using the diagonal line on your ruler.
8. Arrange the 16 half-square triangles as shown (Picture 1), and sew together. Press and square up to 12-1/2".
