

Friendship Block for Community Quilts

Due date: 1 month

Initiated February 2017

Pam Beebe has selected this modern block. There is no limit to the number of blocks she will accept, within the time frame.

The block is **12" finished (12-1/2" unfinished)**

Fabric No fabric is provided, but you will need small amounts of 3 black and white prints and a bright color, and a bit more of a black and white print for the border. Note: the "black" fabric in the image is actually a print. Doesn't matter whether the print is black on white or white on black, but the border print should stand out.



Cutting instructions:

- A From each of 3 black and white prints cut a strip 8-1/2" x 2-1/2".
- B From the bright fabric cut a strip 8-1/2" x 2-1/2".
- C From the border fabric cut 2 strips 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" and 2 strips 12-1/2" x 2-1/2".

Construction

- 1 Following the image, sew the A and B pieces together; you should have an 8-1/2" square.
- 2 Sew a short C piece to each side. Your piece should now measure 12-1/2" x 8-1/2".
- 3 Sew the remaining C pieces to top and bottom to complete the border.
