




Appliqué

 Trace the nose & kitty template including face onto the paper side of fusible web. Roughly cut around the shapes. Iron onto the back of corresponding fabric scraps. Cut out shapes.



Log Cabin


4. With right sides together, attach a strip to the top of the appliqué square. Working clockwise, attach another strip to the right side & then the bottom. Press & trim excess after adding each strip.




Transfer the face from the template using a water soluble marker, or chalk pencil for darker fabrics.



 Continue adding strips until the block is roughly an 11½" square. Aim for a total of 3 strips on each side. TIP: Always add the strip to the side that has three fabrics along the edge.



Peel the backing paper from the kitty & nose appliqués.
Position on the 3½" square. Iron in place. TIP: To protect your iron, use parchment paper between the iron & appliqués.



Quilt ***Quilt, paint, or stitch face on Cat

7. Freemotion quilt around the edge of the kitty appliqué to secure. Using contrasting thread, sew the face tacking down the nose as you sew. TIP: You can also hand-embroider the face using 2 strands of embroidery floss.
