Making the Quilt Blocks

First off name your coordinate fabrics A and B and paste them here. A B

Sew a coordinate A, 2 1/2" x 6 1/2", to the strata piece that you made a head of time with B fabric in the middle.

Now do the same with coordinate B, 2 1/2" x 6 1/2", to the strata piece with A fabric in the middle. Make nine each and press to the coordinate fabric.



Now sew background fabric, $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x $4 \frac{1}{2}$, to the bottom of block A. Make 9 and press toward the background fabric. Do the same for block B but sew the background fabric to the top of

block. Sew block together. is block 1.

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Sew a, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square to each of the 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" coordinates A and B on one side only. Make 21 of each and press to the background fabric.



Now sew a, $4 \frac{1}{2}$ x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$, to the middle of the strips that you just made. Refer to picture. 9 going in one direction and 12 going in the opposite direction. Press to background fabric. This is 2.



block



Sew rows together. First row will have 3 feature fabric blocks and 3 block 2s for a total of 6 blocks.

Next row is 3, block 2s and 3, block 1s. You will have a total of 7 rows.
