## This month you'll be making two sets of blocks:

A) Petal Pouch blocks as demonstrated in the April 2022 TSW video. You will make 4 of them, 2 each of 2 different color

combinations. Use fabrics G, H, I, and solid 1

## Required precut pieces

Fabric	Per block dark Make 2	Per block light Make 2	Total

1) Cut curved pieces using provided template. Mark center of curves with pin, right sides together. Sew curve, press seam toward print fabric. Trim unit to 4.5" x 4.5"







2) Press all the 4 1/2" squares diagonally in half. Press the curves as shown. To reduce bulk begin curves 1/4" from edges.





3) Baste two matching curved triangles to opposite corners of the 4 3/4" square at 1/8" along outside edges. Stitch down the curves 1/16" along the curves. I have used contrasting thread so you are able to see where to stitch. I would recommend a matching colored thread for your finished block.



4) Final step: baste the last curved triangle to the bottom corner of the block.



## B) Trellis blocks - make 12 - label as Side 1

1) **Quarter Square Triangles**:With RST, sew Fabric A & Fabric D triangles together (short side) and Fabric C & Fabric B triangles together (short side). Press seams in opposite directions. Stitch the two sections together (center seam). Press seam open.



2) **Trim blocks to 4.5" X 4.5" squares. IMPORTANT**: Make sure center point is in the middle of the block - you will be trimming approximately the same amount on all 4 sides.
