



Mystery Quilt 2022 - Final assembly

Required for Final assembly

Fabrics	Description	Precut pieces
B	Geometric	(4) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (4) 2" x 6" rectangles. (4) 2" x 7" rectangles
E	Dark blender (in same color range as background)	(5) 3 1/4" x WOF. (4) 1 3/4" x WOF.
F	Small print playful with multi variations of all colors in your fabric selections	(4) 2 1/4" x WOF.
I	Small floral print- medium	(4) strips 1" x 15"
Solid 4	Solid - dark vibrant shade of your favorite flower color	(1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" square. (4) 2" x 3 3/8" rectangles. (4) 1 3/4" x 8 5/8" strips. (4) 1 3/4" x 10 1/4" strips.
Leaves 1	Spring green leaves on white	(4) 1 3/4" x 1 5/8" rectangles
Leaves 2	Various green leaves on white	(4) 1 3/4" x 1 5/8" rectangles

Assemble the Center Block:


- 1) Sew two Fabric B rectangles 1 1/2" x 5" to two opposite sides of the Solid 4 square 1 1/2" x 1 1/2".
- 2) Sew a Fabric B rectangle 1 1/2" x 5 to a light petal block along the right side edge with the small print fabric.
- 3) Sew a dark petal block along it's left side edge with the small print to the other side of the Fabric B rectangle used in step 2. Pressing seams toward the center strips.
- 4) Repeat steps 2 & 3 with remaining two petal blocks.



- 5) Now sew the strip from step 1 aligning the square with the rectangles you created with the petal blocks in steps 2&3. Pressing the seams toward the center strip. Unfinished block 9 7/8" x 9 7/8"



- 6) Assemble next border strips. Use the Solid 4 rectangles 2" x 3 3/8". Place two pairs of same length Fabric B (2" x 6" or 2" x 7") right sides together at right angles to the solid rectangle one at a time. Draw a diagonal line from center to outside edge, sew along diagonal line, trim to 1/4" seam press geometric fabric along the diagonal. Repeat this process to make for all four border strips. See photo for details of construction.



- 7) Align and sew the shorter border strips along opposite sides so that the triangle base is centered above the sashing between the petal pouch blocks of the petal block constructed in step 5. Press seams toward the border. Now align and sew the longer border strips on remaining two sides, again the triangle base should be centered above sashing. Trim excess from corners press seams towards the border. See center block assembly photo above on page 2. The unfinished measurement to this point is 12 6/8" x 12 6/8".

- 8) Sew on small border strips of Fabric I (1" X 15"). Press the seams toward the small border. Unfinished 13 5/8" x 13 5/8".

- 9) Attach a mosaic triangle to opposite sides, each will have a Leave 1 in the far ends of the triangle base. When sewn on the flange will peak through 1/8". Press seams toward the small border. Add the last two mosaic triangles, each will have a Leave 2 in the far ends of the triangle base. Press seams toward the small border. Unfinished measurement 19" x 19"



10) Assemble next border strips. Use a Leave 1, a Leave 2 and two of same length Solid 4 strips ($1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $8\frac{5}{8}$ " or $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{4}$ "). Determine which order to sew the leaves rectangles together based on which side the strip will be sewn on. They should be opposite of the mosaic leaves. Attach a solid strip to each side of the leave rectangles; Align the leaves as shown in photo. Sew on opposite sides and press seams toward the border. Unfinished measurement $21\frac{1}{2}$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ "




11) Layout all the 8 connector blocks and the 8 hexagon blossom blocks per the layout configuration drawing on page 5. Sew 2 connector blocks on the sides of the dark tipped blossom blocks. Attach two of these sets to the opposite sides of the completed center block assembly. Sew a light tip blossom block on each end of the remaining 2 connector block/dark tipped blossom sets. Attach each of these to the opposite sides. Unfinished measurement 35 " x 35 "





12) Sew on Fabric F border strips ($2\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF). Then sew on Fabric E border strips ($1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF). Unfinished measurement $40\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ "

13) Using the 44 Quarter Square Triangles assemble the trellis border following the detailed layout on page 6. Sew the sides onto the quilt top attaching the short sides 2 & 4 in the placement specified on the layout then attach the long sides 1 & 3 in placement specified on the layout. Unfinished measurement 48 " x 48 "

14) Sew on the final border, Fabric E strips ($3\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF)
