

Northern Lights Workshop

Fabric requirements & pre-work

Refer to the quilt block planning diagram to help with planning/purchasing fabric.

Quilt size: 56" x 56"

You really want fabrics "A" (position 1)
(& somewhat "E" - position 5) to POP.

Fabric A	7/8 yard
Fabric B	2 yards
Fabric C	1 yard
Fabric D	1 yard
Fabric E	7/8 yard
Fabric F	2 yards, small squares, outer border and binding



Two sets of instructions are listed below, 1) cutting for the entire quilt and 2) cutting just what is needed for the class. This way if you like to cut everything ahead of time, you can or if you're super busy and can't get to it until the night before, just cut what's needed for the class.

Cutting instructions for the ENTIRE quilt:

Fabric A : Cut 9 strips 3" then sub cut 36 (3" X 9 ½ ") - Position 1

Fabric B: Cut 5 strips 2" x WOF - First border
Cut 18 strips 2 1/2" then sub cut 72 (2 ½ " x 8 ½ ") - Position 2
Cut 6 strips 1 1/2" then sub cut 36 (1 ½ " x 7") - Position 6

Fabric C: Cut 12 strips 2 1/2" then sub cut 72 (2 1/2" x 7") - Position 3

Fabric D: Cut 12 strips 2 1/2" then sub cut 72 (2 ½ " x 7") - Position 4

Fabric E: Cut 11 strips 2 1/2" then sub cut 72 (2 ½" x 6") - Position 5

Fabric F: Cut 1 strip 5 1/2", then sub cut 4 (5 ½" squares)
Cut 6 strips 5 1/2" for outside border
Cut 6 strips 2 1/4" for binding

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OR Cutting instructions for just what's needed for class:

Fabric A : 8 - 3" X 9 ½ " - Position 1

Fabric B: 16 - 2 ½ " x 8 ½ " - Position 2
16 - 1 ½ " x 7" - Position 6

Fabric C : 16 - 2 1/2" x 7" - Position 3

Fabric D: 16 - 2 ½ " x 7"- Position 4

Fabric E : 16- 2 ½" x 6"- Position 5

Fabric F: 4 - 5 ½" squares

Additional items you'll want to bring to class.

quilting ruler at least 12"
Freezer paper (I'll bring some too)
Cutting Mat & rotary cutter
Sewing machine + sewing machine manual
Basic sewing supplies:
Extra needles, pins, small scissors, seam ripper
Fine point sharpie
1/4" foot
Add a quarter ruler 12" long (optional)
