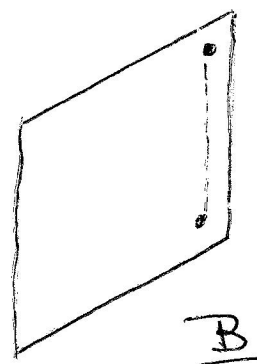


Set-In Seams or Y Seams

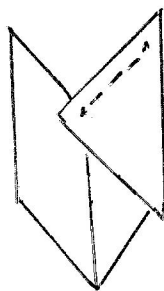
1. Mark a dot on wrong side of each piece at intersection of $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances as shown in Photo A.

2. Join 2 diamonds, stitching from dot to dot; backstitch at dots (*Photo B*). Press seam allowance to one side.

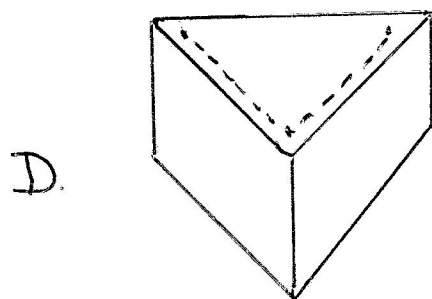


3. Pin 1 triangle to diamond unit, aligning dots. Stitch from center dot to outer edge (*Photo C*).

4. Stitch triangle to adjoining diamond unit to complete 1 side unit (*Photo D*). Make 4 side units.



5. Join side units (*Photo E*).



Always press seam

allowances in the same direction.
