

## Circle Receiving Blanket instructions

Please wash materials before cutting. Required materials for one blanket: 2 yards fabric (1 yd cotton and one yard flannel), tape measure, marking tool, iron, thread, and scissors.

1. Fold fabric into quarters. Lightly press folds.



2. Fold again one corner to the other, making a triangle.



3. Measure 18" from the center point of the triangle to the outer edges marking along the way.

4. Cut out your circle.



5. Fold the remaining fabric into quarters then use the circle you just cut out as the pattern for second fabric.



6. Sew right sides together (zigzag stitching). Leave an opening to turn right side out.



7. Turn right side out, press outer edges flat, top stitch (zigzag for ruffled edge or straight stitch for flat) and viola.



Note: I press the two fabrics together in addition to pinning together. I like the way the flannel sticks to the cotton for easier sewing. Using a zigzag stitch not only fortifies the stitching but it also makes your edges ruffle.

Enjoy this super simple pattern for a great project.
