

→ Photocopy the paper pattern for the envelope size you choose to make. Tape the left and right sides together. Cut the paper pattern out on the ouside solid line. Mark the outline onto two pieces of fabric (one lining, one outer fabric) that are right sides together. Sew exactly on that marked line all the way around the shape of the envelope.



Fold the sides to the center first. f TNext, the flat-top lower corner is folded up. Blind stitch the sides that are shown above with arrows, reenforcing the top edges. Add round Velcro dots, snaps or buttons to close the top flap (the button hole is applied before closing the sides). Embellishments may be added to the front of the top flap to look like an envelope seal.











We have provided only the envelope patterns. It is up to you to create your own love letters.
