CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background:

1 ea. 7-1/4" square 8 ea. 2-1/2" squares 4 ea. 3-1/8" squares 2 ea. 4-1/2" squares

Color fabrics:

8 ea. 2-1/2" squares 8 ea. 2-1/2" x 3-1/8" rectangles 2 ea. 4-1/2" squares

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

A Unit - Center Block: Make one (Pictures 2,3)


- 1. Draw diagonal lines on the reverse side of each of the 2-1/2" color squares and background squares.
- Place one 2-1/2" color square on each corner of the 7-1/4" background square, right sides together and edge to edge. Stitch along the diagonal lines. Trim 1/4" above the stitched lines and press seam to the color side.

B Unit - Hourglass Blocks: Make four (Pictures 5,6)

- 1. With right sides together, layer one 4-1/2" background square and one 4-1/2" color square. Draw a diagonal cutting line and stitch parallel lines 1/4" on both sides. Cut on the diagonal cut line and press both pieces to the color fabric.
- 2. Layer the two pieces with right sides together, seams aligned, and colors opposite. Draw a diagonal line that crosses the seam. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the line, and cut along the line. You will have two hourglass blocks. Press. Using a grid ruler, trim to 3-1/8" square.

C and CR Units - Side blocks: Make four regular (C) and four mirrored (CR) (Pictures 7,8)

- 1. With right sides together and edge to edge, place one 2-1/2" background square on one corner of a 2-1/2" x 3-1/8" rectangle. Stitch along the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" above the line, trim, and press.
- 2. Repeat for the remaining units, being certain to make four regular (C) and four mirrored (CR).

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D Units - Corner Blocks: Make four (Picture 9)

- 1. Place one 2-1/2" color square right sides together and edge to edge in one corner of a background 3-1/8" square. Stitch along diagonal and trim excess fabric at 1/4" from the seam. Press to obtain one corner block.
- 2. Repeat for the remaining three corner blocks.

Assemble the units:

- 1. Stitch one side unit and one mirror side unit to each side of an hourglass block. Be sure the color section of the hourglass block is next to the center of the finished block. (Picture 10)
- 2. Repeat for the remaining hourglass and side units. Stitch one of these units to either side of the center unit. (Picture 11)
- 3. Add a corner unit to each side of the two remaining hourglass/side unit. Orient the color portion toward the center. (Picture 12)
- 4. Stitch the side units/corner pieces to the center section to complete the block. (Picture 1)

Note: Please write your name on a back side seam of each block you submit in order to be entered into the drawing to be held at our guild meeting on September 1. Bring your blocks to Rena or Kay at our meetings, or to Village Sewing Center, or mail them to us, or contact us to arrange for pickup. Since all of our BOMs this year feature half-square triangles and flying geese, we think you'll be a pro and find this block goes together quite easily!
