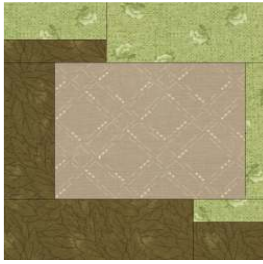


Santa Rosa Quilt Guild  
Block of the Month  
December

Due Thursday, January 5, 2017



Modern fabrics are bold in color and print with high contrast. Modern blocks are updated classic quilt patterns. The designs are minimalist with large areas of negative space.

Supplies:

Choose three shades of green fabrics:

Cutting:

From Color 1 (center) – cut one 5" x 6" rectangle

From Color 2 (light) - cut one 3 ½" x 1 ¾" rectangle

cut one 6" x 2 ½" rectangle

cut one 5" x 2" rectangle

cut one 3 ½" x 1 ¼" rectangle

From Color 3 (dark) - repeat above cutting instructions for Color 3

Assemble:

Use a ¼" seam allowance throughout.



To make center unit:

Sew one Color 2 (light) 2" x 5" to right side of center rectangle;

sew one Color 3 (dark) 2" x 5" to left side of center rectangle.



To make top unit:

Sew one Color 2 (light) 3 ½" x 1 ¾" to one Color 3 (dark) 3 ½" x 1 ¼"



Sew one Color 2 (light) 6" x 2 ½" to the right of the completed piece above.



To make bottom unit:

Sew one Color 3 (dark) 3 ½" x 1 ¾" to one Color 2 (light) 3 ½" x 1 ¼"



Sew one Color 3 (dark) to the left side of the completed piece above



Assemble top, center, and bottom as shown

Write your name on the seam allowance or pin your name to your block. Block is complete and will measure 9" x 9" unfinished and 8 ½" x 8 ½" finished.

All blocks for the 2016 BOM modern sampler will measure 8 ½" x 8 ½". Make one for Block of the Month and one for yourself if you would like to have a modern sampler at the end of the year.
