

March Mittens Madness

The block is 12 ½ unfinished

BACKGROUND (should be light)

- A. 4 ea. 1 1/2 by 1 1/2 (top corner)
- F. 2 ea. 1 by 1 (thumb)
- G. 2 ea. 1 1/2 by 3 3/4 (top of thumb)
- H. 2 ea. 1 1/2 by 7 1/2 (side)
- I. 4 ea. 2 by 2 (bottom of mitten)
- K. 4 ea. 1 1/2 by 2 (side of cuff)
- L. 2 ea. 4 1/2 by 5 1/2 (top and bottom)
- M. 2 1/2 by 12 1/2 (center)

BODY OF MITTEN (any color)

- B. 2 ea. 2 by 3 1/2 (top of mitten)
- D. 2 ea. 3 1/2 by 4 1/2 (body of mitten)
- E. 2 ea. 1 1/2 by 4 1/4 (thumb)

CONTRAST (any contrasting color)

- C. 2 ea. 2 by 3 1/2 (middle of mitten)
- J. 2 ea. 1 1/2 by 2 1/2 (cuff)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw diagonal lines on back of blocks A, F and I.
2. Sew A blocks on both corners of B. Cut and flip. Attach C and D .



3. Sew F on corner of E, making sure one is the right thumb and one is the left thumb (see picture). Cut and flip. Attach G to the top of the thumb and attach that unit to the mitten. Add H to the opposite side of the mitten, again note the right and left mitten will be different sides.



4. Sew I diagonally onto the entire mitten unit, cut and flip. Attach K on each side of J and add this unit to the mitten.



5. Attach L to the bottom of the left mitten and the top of the right mitten. Add M to the center and now you have a pair of March mittens! Congratulations!
