Santa Rosa Quilt Guild

Block-of-the-Month September 2022

"Variable Star Variation"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background:

3 ea. 7" squares

4 ea. 2-1/2" squares

Color fabrics: Three different colors

Color A - 2 ea. 7" squares

Color B - 3 ea. 7" squares

Color C - 1 ea. 4-1/2" square

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. On the wrong side of the background squares, draw two diagonal lines (X).

- 2. Align one background square with one Color A square, right sides together.
- 3. Sew 1/4" on both sides of both lines (X). (Picture 2)
- 4. Cut in half top to bottom and left to right (+).
- 5. Cut on diagonal lines (X) to make 8 half-square triangles.
- 6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 with two Color B and two background squares to make 16 half-square triangles.
- 7. Repeat steps 1 through 5 with one Color A and one Color B square to make 8 half-square triangles. Note: You will have four extra 2-color HST's for another project.
- Cut line
 Sew line
- 8. Press the half-square triangles to the color side, and square up each one to 2-1/2", using the diagonal line on your ruler.
- 9. Arrange the 28 half-square triangles as shown (Picture 1), and sew together with the Color C block in the center and the 2-1/2" background squares in each corner. Press and square up to 12-1/2".

Note: Please write your name on a back side seam of each block you submit in order to be entered into the *drawing to be held on November 3*. Turn your blocks in to Rena or Kay at our in-person meetings, or to Village Sewing Center, or mail them to us, or contact us to arrange for pickup.
