"Triple Star"

This block will be a great use for that red, white, and blue fabric in your stash.
Of course, a variety of prints makes a more interesting quilt!
Fabric (Photo 2):

Background: BLUE
4 ea. 3-1/2" squares
16 ea. 2-1/2" squares

Assorted RED and WHITE prints:
8 ea. 5-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
4 ea. $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
1 ea. $2-1 / 2$ " square

6. At this point lay all the units out in the completed pattern for the block. Then proceed. (Photo 8)
7. Sew two of the units from step 5 to opposite sides of the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print square in the center. Press seams. (Photo 8)
8. Sew one step 2 unit to each side of one step 5 unit. The larger blue square is always on the outside corner.
9. Repeat step 8 for the remaining 3 units, joining step 2 and step 5 units.
10. Assemble the sections. Press so the center square seams are flat. (Photo 1)
