## "Irish Chain Variation"

May the luck of the Irish be with you as we create this classic block
Unfinished block is 12-1/2", Sew all seams a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press to dark when possible.

## Fabric:

Fabric \#1 - white tone on tone
Fabric \#2 - green print

## Cutting the Fabric:

From Fabric \#1:

1. Cut 2 ea. 1-7/8" strips WOF (Width of Fabric.) Cut strips in half.
2. Cut 4-4-1/2" squares.

From Fabric \#2:

1. Cut 2 ea. $-1-7 / 8$ " strips WOF. Cut strips in half.

## Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew fabric strips together to make $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide strip sets $A$ \& $B$.
2. Cut strip sets into 1-7/8" pieces.

3. Sew two pieces of set $A$ and one of set $B$ as shown. Make 5.

4. Sew the 4-1/2" blocks of fabric \#1 with the 9-patch blocks to finish your Irish Chain block as shown.
