Fabric Choices and Cutting Instructions:

Cream or off-white Fabric -

• Cut 1 square 4.5 inches by 4.5 inches (A)

Fabric of Your Choice with a Dark Value -

- Cut 1 square 4.5 inches by 4.5 inches (B)
 - Cut 1 strip 8.5 inches by 4.5 inches (C)

Fabric of Your Choice in a Medium Value -

- Cut 1 strip 4.5 by 8.5 inches (D)
- Cut 1 strip 12.5 inches by 4.5 inches (E)

Sewing Instructions:

Use ¼ inch seam allowances.

1. With rights sides together, sew the square A to the square B.


Press toward square B.

2. With right sides together, sew the strip C to the top of the squares from Step 1. Press toward square C.

3. With right sides together, sew the strip D to the left side of unit from Step 2. Press toward strip D.

4. With right sides together, sew strip E to the top of the unit from Step 3. Press toward strip E.

5. Trim the block to 12.5 by 12.5 inches.
