

Santa Rosa Quilt Guild Block-of-the-Month November 2025

"Second Star"

Fabric

White/Off white 8 - 2" squares - A 8 - 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles - B Orange solid/print 16 – 2" squares - C Coordinating Fall print 2 – 3 1/2" squares - D 2 – 6 1/2" squares - E

Sewing Directions:

- 1. Flying geese units: On the wrong side of each orange 2" (C) square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner. Using the white 2" x 3-1/2" (B) rectangles make eight flying geese units. Unit should measure 2" x 3-1/2".
- 2. Lay out the **(A)** squares, flying geese units, and **(D)** square as shown. Join units to make the sawtooth star units as shown below. Make 2. Trim each star to 6-1/2" square.



3. Lay out the **(E)** squares and the sawtooth stars as shown above. Join units to make the full block. Trim to 12-1/2".

This block was designed for the Moda Blockheads 5 Quilt Along. It was designed by Jackie MacDonald of Sweetfire Road.

Unfinished size of block is 12-1/2". Please print your name on a backside seam of each block you submit so you will be eligible to win more blocks. The drawing(s) will be held at our guild meeting on January 15, 2026.
