### “Tulip”

**Fabric:** Your choice of colors

#### Background(BG)

#### Lights or scrappy



Flower Top:	Stem Portion
2- 2" x 3"	4- 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"
2- 2"x 4-1/2'	
2- 2" x 2"	Sashing
	4- 2-1/2" x 8-1/2"

#### Stem (S)

1- 1-1/4" x 4-1/2"  
 2-4-1/2 x 4-1/2'  
 2-2-1/2' x 2-1/2"

#### Flower(F)



4- 1-3/4" x 1-3/4"  
 1- 5-1/2" x3"  
 2- 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"



#### Sewing Directions:

##### Flower

1. using 1- 2 x 3 (BG) place 2- 1-3/4 x 1-3/4(F) on each corner. Sew diagonally as shown in diagram, flip open , trim and iron  
Make second one. Sew together
2. take the 3 x 5-1/5 (F) place the 2 x 2 (BG) on bottom corners, sew diagonally, flip open and iron.
3. Sew top and bottom of flower together.
4. Add 2 x 4-1/2 (BG) to both sides of flower, iron and square to 4-1/2 x 8- 1/2.



##### Stem

5. Take (S) 4-1/2 x 4-1/2 place (BG) 3-1/4 x 3-1/4 on opposite corners As shown in diagram, flip open, trim and iron  
Make a second one a mirror image. Careful of (BG) placement!
6. Sew leaves to (S) 1-1/2 x 4-1/2 iron
7. Center stem to flower top, sew together. There will be excess leaves to trim off.  
Square to 8-1/2 x 8-1/2
8. Add side sashings (BG) 8-1/2 x8-1/2.  
Make top and bottom sashings by adding the 2-1/2 x 2-1/2 squares of (F) and (S) to the (BG) 2-1/2 x 8-1/2 sew as shown
9. Iron, trim to 12-1/2 x 12-1/2 . Write your name on your Tulip
10. Drawing for the Tulip will be in April
