"Card Trick"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background fabric

- ◆ 2 ea. 5" squares
- ◆ 1 ea. 5-1/4" square

Color fabric - 4 colors


- ◆ 1 ea. 5" square of each color
- ◆ 1 ea. 5-1/4" square of each color

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut the 5" background squares diagonally to make four *half-square triangles* (A).
2. Cut the 5" color squares diagonally to make two *half-square triangles* (A) of each color.
3. Cut the 5-1/4" background square diagonally *twice* to make four *quarter-square triangles* (B.) Cut the 5-1/4" color squares diagonally *twice* to make four *quarter-square triangles* (B) of each. You will have *two extra quarter-square triangles of each color*—to use in another project.
4. *Note: It's helpful to lay out all triangles and squares in the Card Trick block before sewing them. See picture #1.*
5. Right sides together, sew one background *half-square triangle* (A) to each color *half-square triangle* (A) to make four blocks. Press to color side and square up to 4-1/2".
6. Right sides together, sew one background *quarter-square triangle* (B) to one color *quarter-square triangle* (B) (side-by-side) to make two *half-square units*. Press to color side.
7. Right sides together, sew two *quarter-square triangle* (B) colors together (side-by-side) to make four units. Press to dark side.
8. Sew one *half-square triangle* (A) to two *quarter-square triangles* (B) to make four blocks. Press and square up to 4-1/2".
9. Sew one *quarter-square triangle* (B) of each color together to make the center block. Press and square up to 4-1/2" See picture #2.
10. Sew the nine 4-1/2" squares together. Press and square up to 12-1/2".

Note: Please write your name on a backside seam of each of the 12-1/2" blocks you make. A drawing ticket will be made and collected for you.

Blocks can be turned in during our in-person meetings. They are also being collected at Village Sewing Center for us to pick up, or can be mailed to either Rena Ferrero or Kay Hartman. Our addresses are in the roster.
